JUDGMENT No. 23

17 There was entered by this Court on April 7, 1961,
18 Interlocutory Judgment No. 23, concerning the appropriate
19 rights of the Fallbrook Public Utility District.

20 GOOD CAUSE APPEARING THEREFORE, and in order to further
21 clarify the rulings of this Court as to the powers of the Fallbrook
22 Public Utility District to appropriate waters for irrigation,
23 domestic and municipal uses,

24 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED that the
25 Conclusions of Law contained in said Interlocutory Judgment
26 No. 23 be amended by adding thereto the following additional
27 Conclusion of Law:


